**School time**

**Things to note about returning to school**

- \*Students are required to wear masks and bring along tissue paper.
- \* Please bring along two spare masks.
- \*Parents are required to wear masks upon arrival at school and take their body temperature before coming to school. For the sake of students' health, parents should not enter classrooms.
- \*If the school car park is full, parents who drive should wait at the roundabout opposite to the school.
- \*If feeling unwell (especially having fever), students should not come to school and should seek medical attention immediately.
- \*Students should take their body temperature and fill in the Temperature Record Sheet before going to school. The teacher on duty will check the record upon student's arrival to school.

**Reporting Confirmed Cases of Infection**

\* After the resumption of classes, parents should notify the school immediately in case of any of the following situations, to facilitate our prompt action in taking contingency measures and informing the EDB:

- (a) your child has been confirmed infection of COVID-19; or
- (b) your child has been classified as “close contact of an infected person” with COVID-19

#### Care for sick students

The school will provide designated quarantine spaces for sick students to wait for parent pick-up.

#### Emotional support for students

If parents suspect that students are having emotional distress, please seek the advice of the school social worker (Miss Cheng) or the class teacher.

#### School tuck shop

The school tuck shop will be closed. Parents should prepare breakfast or snacks for their children.

#### Classroom arrangement

Classrooms will maintain good ventilation. Students' desks will be placed across the classroom, allowing the most space between desks.

#### Campus hygiene conditions

- \*Desks, chairs, blackboards, light switches, door knobs, book shelves and the floor are cleaned regularly using 1 in 99 diluted household bleach
- \*The bathrooms are disinfected regularly every day.
- \*Hand rails on each floor will be cleaned.
- \* The activity rooms and school office are disinfected regularly every day.
- \*Rubbish bins are emptied and disinfected regularly.
- \*Windows and doors are cleaned every day .
